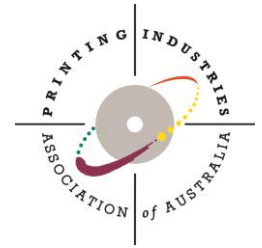




## Category # 3 Environment Award 2017 Printing Industries Craftsmanship Awards

This award recognises and encourages those companies who are not only managing their environmental impacts to a high standard, but are also seeking to build upon current practices and make further improvements.

Nominations will be accepted in three categories based on staff size-

- Small (1-15 staff)
- Medium (16-40) and
- Large (41+).

There will be one award presented in each staff size category.

Criteria and entry requirements for the PICA Environment Award are listed over leaf. **All questions (1-3) must be answered to be considered for judging.** A template has been attached to assist you with your submission.

**Please note answers to questions can be completed in a separate document and attached to the entry form (included as the last page) for submission.**

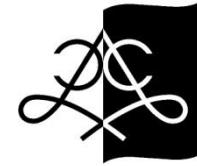


